- 1799 Inventory Ledger [possibly from USS UNITED STATES]. Contains lists of the stores of each department, including gunner, sail maker, boatswain, carpenter, steward, and lists of rigging and sails divided by sail. Dated on the pages listing boatswain's supplies, January and June 1799. A small piece of paper separated from the rest is incomplete but seems to be a receipt for wood for USS UNITED STATES. Mentions Josiah Fox, Washington Navy Yard, oak, and other wood and materials. Signed by "Jno Petherbridge" and dated 1806.

- 1803 December 17 Report of a survey of barrels of pork and beef that was found to be unfit for consumption and thrown over board. Dated in harbor of Saragosa, Sicily 17th December 1803. Signed by John Dent, Thomas Robinson, Charles Gordon, Nathaniel Haraden, Ralph Izard, William Burrows, David Deacon.
